Program Policies & Requirements

1. Classroom Lessons:

- Attendance in class is mandatory.
- No more than two (2) absences allowed; more results in removal without refund.
- Makeup work must be arranged with the instructor.
- Arriving late counts as an absence
- Cancellation of class will coincide with the cancellation of school (Snow days and early release).

2. Driving Lessons:

- Consists of ten (10) hours of driving and six (6) hours of observation. This is in addition to classroom lessons.
- Lessons and observations are scheduled in advance with the instructor.
- Missing a driving lesson without notice: \$85 fee (payable by cash, money order, or bank check no personal checks).

Please Note: 24-hour cancellations are allowed without penalty.

- Arriving late for a scheduled driving session may result in a charge for that session.
- 3. Course Completion Requirements:
 - Must complete 10 hours driving and 6 hours observation.
 - Must document 40 hours of driving with parent or other adult in addition to the 10 hours of driving school lessons.
 - Must pass class requirements with 80% or higher.
 - Must complete all assignments
 - Must have a signed Green Slip Release Form from a parent/guardian
 - Must return all course materials in good condition
 - Note: Students failing must retake (and repay for) the program.

4. Behavior and Conduct:

- No food or drink in classrooms or vehicles.
- Students must make time for required driving; repeated refusal may result in removal without a refund (parents will be contacted first).
- Students who are disruptive, disrespectful, or combative toward any teacher or fellow student will be dismissed from the program without a refund.
- Any cell phone use during class or in a vehicle is considered disruptive unless the instructor has granted prior permission.

5. Payments and Fees:

- \$75 fee for any returned checks.
- The complete cost of the program must be paid in full by the end of the second class to maintain a seat in the program.
- Students will not be allowed driving hours if a missed driving fee is not paid
- A \$75.00 fee will be required to reissue a Green Slip DSMV 210 if lost, damaged or incorrect information is supplied to the company.
- 6. Students are expected to complete all required driving sessions as scheduled. Repeated refusal to drive due to other commitments (work, sports, personal, etc.) may result in removal from the program without a refund if proper accommodations are not made. A parent or guardian will be contacted to discuss the issue before any removal takes place.
- 7. Late pickups will incur a fee, as instructors have scheduled commitments after each lesson.
